208. "OLD WINERY" VERDELHO 2010 23.50
HUNTER VALLEY. A great introduction to the delights of this grape in this region. Tropical fruit and honey balanced by a crisp finish. 12%ABV

209. "OLD WINERY" SEMILLON 2010 23.50
HUNTER VALLEY. This valley is by far the greatest place in the world for oone-dry Semillon. Floral aromas with soft lemons and honeysuckle, plus a clean finish ... and only 10.5%ABV

210. "OLD WINERY" PINOT NOIR 2009 23.50
Good straightforward concentrated fruit - strawberries and cherries. 12.5%ABV

211. GIANT STEPS "Sexton Vineyard" PINOT NOIR 08 39.50
Yarra Valley. Gorgeous, vibrant, juicy raspberries and strawberry fruit with meaty flavours that linger. More Burgundian in style than most Oz Pinots. Brilliant stuff! In fact, one of the few truly great New World pinots. 14%ABV

GRANT BURGE Barossa

212. BAROSSA VINES CHARDONNAY 2009 22.50
Plenty of peach and melon flavours with a creamy, buttery style. 13%ABV

213. BAROSSA VINES CAB-MERLOT 2007 23.50
Generous up-front, soft blackcurrant and mint flavours balanced with a smidgeon of gentle oak. 'Affordable Bordeaux comes to the Barossa'. 14%ABV

214. "MIAMBA" SHIRAZ 2008 29.50
My favourite of all Grant's reds. Lovely gentle spice with a delicate yet robust finish which lingers. 14.5%ABV

215. "CAMERON VALE" CAB SAUVIGNON 2007 29.50
Great! Chocolate, violets and beautiful mint .. with voluptuous oak. 14.5%ABV

216. "THE HOLY TRINITY" 2006 43.95
GRENACHE/SHIRAZ/MOUVEDRE. Heaps of soft, ripe plum, Grenache flavours beautifully balanced with spice and deliciously aromatic with an ethereal, soft, savoury oak finish. 15%ABV

217. GRANT BURGE 'MESHACH' 2005
100 year old vines producing a big win of amazing concentration ..
But there is also a lovely subtlety of oak and spice flavours

SAINT EMILION. 65% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Franc, 5% Cab Sauvignon. Luscious classic from one of the oldest Estates in the appellation. Blackcurrants & cherries with a balanced style & long finish.

51. CHATEAU CITRAN 2001 49.50
CRU BOURGEOIS EXCEPTIONNEL. "Excellent bouquet with good flavour and balance", says David Peppercorn in *The Wines of Bordeaux*. 13%ABV

CHATEAU KIRWAN en magnum3rd Growth Margaux

54. CHATEAU KIRWAN 1999 Magnum 105.00
"A very good vintage", *Decanter*. "Blackcurrant pastille aromas & sweet fruit", *Stephen Brook* in his opus, *The Complete Bordeaux*. 13.5%ABV

55. CHATEAU MAGDELAINE 2002 79.95
GRAND CRU ST. EMILION. "Wonderful traditional character with understated elegance", *Robert Parker*. I say, "A terrific concentration of berries with gently spiced oak". 13.5%ABV

56. DOMAINE DE CHEVALIER 1986 125.00
CRU CLASSÉ GRAVES PESSAC-LÉOGNAN. Elegant gorgeously flowery fruit. "The wines are deep and flavours need time to develop with great breeding and length of flavour", says the estimable *David P.* 12%ABV

57. CHATEAU TALBOT 1985 150.00
4TH GROWTH MEDOC. A marvelous introduction to fine Bordeaux. "The superb, opulent 1985 is truly great wine", says *David Peppercorn*. 13%ABV
